Objective:

Course Objective:

Development of advanced German language skills with an emphasis on grammar, sentence formation, vocabulary, and cultural understanding. The course will primarily focus on developing student's pronunciation and the spontaneous phrasing of sentences in German. The goal of the course is also to specifically introduce the students to various situational based topics that could help them in facilitating conversation and building fluency.

Learning Outcomes:

- Communicate effectively in German in both formal and informal situations, using appropriate grammar and vocabulary.
- Read and comprehend moderately complex texts such as news articles, short stories.
- Develop an understanding into German culture, traditions, and social norms to better understand context and meaning in conversations.

Course Content:

Unit I: Gute Reise, Technik und Geräte:

Grammatik: Infinitiv mit *zu*, Ausdrücken (deshalb, deswegen, darum, daher, sodass/ so....dass), Präpositionen (wegen, trotz).

Unit II: Arbeitswelt und Umwelt:

Grammatik: Konjunktiv II, Verben mit Präposition und Nebensatz, Nebensatz mit *damit, um....zu*.

Unit III: Kunststücke, Stadt, Land, Fluss:

Grammatik: Passiv (Präsens, Präteritum und Perfekt), Stellung von *Nicht* im Satz, Relativsätze *wo* und *was*.
