Shortlisting Criteria:

1. PhD in any aspect of International Relations/ International Politics. Eminent scholar, with a strong background in teaching, research and publishing in international relations theory/international politics/ international security/diplomacy/ foreign policy/history/international organization/geopolitics.
2. Published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2, of UGC Regulations, 2018.
3. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions.
4. Evidence of having successfully guided at least 1 doctoral candidate.

It clearly indicates ambiguity of said experience certificate. NOC from employer was also not found attached along with application. (iii) Candidate has attached self-declaration paper signed on 29.12.2023, for having successfully guided doctoral candidate instead of providing proof to support the said essential eligibility criteria as per advertisement.
