

# **Bahasa Indonesia – Certificate of Proficiency (COP)**

### **1. Course Overview**

Bahasa Indonesia, the national language of Indonesia, belongs to the Austronesian (Malayo-Polynesian) family and has evolved as a major lingua franca across Southeast Asia. Written in Roman script, it carries lexical influences from Sanskrit, Arabic, Persian, Portuguese, and Dutch.

### **2. Course Structure**

- Duration: 2 Semesters
- General Studies (Covers grammar and literature of Bahasa Indonesia, along with the history, geography, and social systems of Indonesia. It further equips students with a broader understanding of Southeast Asia's cultural and geographical landscape.)
