Dr. Sayantan Mandal is an Associate Professor at the Zakir Husain Centre for Educational Studies (ZHCES), Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. He is recognized for his expertise in higher education policy, critical digital education, and innovative teaching-learning practices. Dr. Mandal holds a PhD in Higher Education Policy (Cum Laude) from the University of Deusto, Spain, and a master's degree in Lifelong Learning: Policy and Management from Aarhus University, Denmark, supported by prestigious Erasmus Mundus scholarships. Prior to joining JNU, he served IIT Jammu, where he led pioneering research on digital education integration and teacher competencies in AI-enabled higher education. He has also held academic positions at NIEPA and the University of Delhi, and has been a visiting faculty at the University of British Columbia and University of Deusto. Dr. Mandal has coordinated several national and international research projects, and his scholarly work includes numerous peer-reviewed articles and edited volumes, such as the book "Roadmap for Humanities and Social Sciences in STEM Higher Education" (Springer).
