About program

"Visiting Research Fellowship Program" offers research opportunities for international scholars specialized in the Caspian Sea region and Azerbaijan. Candidates having academic interest in the region are welcome to apply for in-residence fellowships in Baku, Azerbaijan. "Visiting Research Fellowship Program" is carried out in cooperation with the following research institutions of Azerbaijan and is sponsored by the Azerbaijan International Development Agency (AIDA):

- 1- The Centre for Strategic Studies under the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan (SAM) (www.sam.gov.az);
- 2- The Institute of Law and Human Rights, Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences (www.ihr-az.org);
- 3- ADA University (www.ada.edu.az);
- 4- The Center for Analysis of Economic Reforms and Communication (www.ereforms.org).

The host institutions support scholars ("fellows") by providing excellent conditions for conducting their research and by establishing a strong and fruitful network among academics in the country. They have acquired a unique position in the region and have meanwhile established themselves as research centers of international reputation.

Eligibility

- Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for a fellowship award:
- Ideal candidates at the time of application should either already hold or be enrolled in a PhD programme.
- Preference is given to candidates whose research background and interests match the selected topic.
- Have an excellent command of English, both written and verbal

Provision of support

- All fellows are provided with a roundtrip ticket to Azerbaijan.
- Fellows who have requested for the accommodation to be provided by AIDA will be sharing an apartment with I (one) other fellow of the same gender. Each fellow will have his or her private bedroom in the apartment.
- Fellows are granted a monthly stipend of 1500 AZN during the entire period of their fellowship.
- Emergency medical insurance for the period of the program is also covered.
- Accommodation utility bills are not covered by the program (participants are in charge for their gas, electricity, water, phone and internet bills).
- Visa issuing might take a long time. Therefore, we strongly advise you to make the application for 3 month visa to the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan as soon as you receive your confirmation of participation in the program.

Research process

During the period of the program successful candidates will conduct their research on the topic selected from the list provided by AIDA.

With regards to carrying out the research the participants will be provided with work station, available resources. As wireless internet connection is available at the office it is advisable to take your personal laptop with you for your personal convenience.

Participants of the "Visiting Research Fellowship Program" are expected to work five days of a week (9:00-18:00) in the host office.

After meeting with their respective advisors at the work station, within the first 10 working days the researcher has to provide AIDA with the work plan reflecting activities planned to be implemented within the research program. AIDA should be kept informed on any change to the work plan.

Fellows are required to issue two reports, a mid-term report (at the end of the first month) during the fellowship period and a final report (a week before the research presentation) containing the result of research. The aforementioned reports should be submitted to the programme coordinator.

Moreover, researcher is expected to prepare a short (10-15 minutes) presentation on a topic. Program participants are also required to submit their presentation material to the program coordinator.

After completion of the Fellowship Programme, within the period of three months, the researcher is expected to issue and submit to AIDA published or disseminated research article/paper.

Application procedure
