

#### Guest Lecture: Brig. Rajiv Williams






#### Guest Lecture: Mr. Manish Khandelwal

#### Guest Lecture: Mr. Mayank Joshi




# Special Lecture: Shri Sameer Sharma (IRS)

Shri Sameer Sharma (IRS), Finance Officer, Jawaharlal Nehru University elaborated in detail about the "Financial Management and Income Tax".


He briefly discussed all saving for Income Tax and supplemented this with many examples. He also pointed out India's tax system and its role in Economy.

# Saraswati Puja 2020




