## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ELECTION OF STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO IC

1. As per clause 4.1 (c) vide Resol. No.5.3/EC/18 09.2017 election of three student representatives each from the following three constituencies will be conducted.
  - a. Under Graduate - B.A./B.Tech./B.Sc.
  - b. PostGraduate - M.A./M.Tech./M.Sc./MBA
  - c. ResearchScholar - Ph.D.

Note: Only one candidate from one constituency shall be elected.

2. The office bearers of JNUSU/Counsellors shall not be eligible for contesting IC Election.
3. The student member of IC shall also not be eligible to contest JNUSU elections.
4. Out of the three students representative to IC, at least two are reserved for female candidates and one is reserved for male. Further, on the basis of rotation, the Committee decided that Post Graduate and Ph.D. constituencies are earmarked for female candidates and Under Graduate constituency is earmarked for male for the year 2024-25.
5. The term of elected members shall be one academic year only.
6. Students of respective constituency as mentioned in point no.1 can cast his/her vote to his/her constituency only.
7. A student member once elected to IC shall not be eligible for re-election to IC.
8. The Committee decided the following rules for contesting IC election.
  - a. Candidates shall submit their nominations in the prescribed format available at Dean of Students Office.
  - b. A student can file nomination only for his/her respective constituency.
  - c. Only a bonafide student of JNU pursuing regular course of study is eligible to contest IC election.
  - d. Proposer, seconder and the candidate must be from the same constituency.
  - e. One member can either propose or second only one candidate for office bearers.
9. Candidates contesting for IC election shall abide by the rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Presiding Officer/ Dean of Students.
10. Decisions of the Presiding Officer, Election Committee in all matters pertaining to elections shall be final and binding.
11. All students shall carry their valid JNU identity cards at the time of casting their votes. If JNU identity card is not available, student is required to carry latest registration folio with Aadhar card.
12. Voting shall take place at Convention Centre, JNU from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on 05.11.2024.
13. All queries & complaints with respect of IC election shall be addressed to the Presiding Officer, IC Election Committee.
14. The votes shall be casted by postal-ballot papers.
15. A candidate can nominate maximum of three authorized nominee for polling/counting; however only one nominee for the candidate is permitted inside polling booth/counting station.
16. A candidate/authorized nominee of the candidate shall be present at the polling booth at least one hour before the scheduled time of voting i.e. 8:00 am on 05.11.2024.
17. If a candidate or his/her nominee fails to be present at the time of polling/counting: polling/counting will not be paused or delayed and shall carry on as per the schedule.
