1. First, go to the Home Screen on your Android Device, and click on "Wi-Fi". (If it is not showing, then pull down the top menu until you see it.) Once open, select the wireless connection called "JNU Academic", "JNU Campus", "JNU Residence"

- Under "EAP method", select "PEAP".
- Under "Phase 2 authentication", select "MSCHAPV2"
- Under "CA certificate", select "Use system certificates"
- Online certificate "Don't validate"
- Under "Domain" type "jnu.ac.in"
- Under "Identity", type your username. (Provided by the CIS)
- Under "Anonymous Identity" type your username.
- Under "Password", type your password.
