How to reach JNU

JNU is reached from the airport by a taxi. Buses are available, but good working knowledge is required for getting around Delhi roads. Take a pre-paid taxi. Fares are in the range of Rs. 300 – 350. JNU can be reached from the New Delhi railway station direct by bus Route No. 615 from the Minto Road station. Get off within the JNU campus at the Administrative Block and walk for 5 min to SPS.

How to reach SPS

Enter the campus through the North Gate, behind Munirka. Take a token and drive straight 900 m to reach the first T point. Take a left turn and drive 200 m to reach the 2nd T point (Administrative Block bus stand). Take a right turn. Drive straight, ignore the first left and take the 2nd left turn (100 m from the last T point). The SPS building is 50 m from this turn, on your right.
