1. CDSL and NSDL both the agencies shortlisted by the UGC/MHRD for NAD implementation at universities/institutes were invited to give the presentation on their solution offering to JNU. Each agency was given a separate slot to discuss about their solution offering and to present their NAD implementation proposal for JNU. Both the agencies presented their solution & proposals before the committee. The committee also discussed about the Service Level Agreement (SLA) documents including charges as per the directives of UGC/MHRD.
2. The committee also informed both agencies to submit JNU evaluation criteria details in writing / email latest by 22nd August 2017 for further comparing their proposals and further enabling the committee to select an agency for NAD implementation at JNU.
3. The comparative statement of the responses received from both the agencies are enclosed herewith at Annexure - I.



Comparative statement of Evaluation Criteria for selecting agency for NAD implementation at JNU, dated 21.8.2017, Annexure-I

As per MHRD/UGC guidelines, NAD system has been designed and structured in a way which is user friendly wherein Academic Institutions (AIs) are required to upload the digitally signed data pertaining to academic records of its students through a secure login in a prescribed format which is approved by MHRD/UGC. As the data format is uniformly applied and published, JNU can prepare the records for lodgment in the same format. It may be appreciated that in NAD the records are to be lodged under Digital Signatures and are to be authorized using Maker / Checker functionality by authorized officers of JNU. Depository system also has interface for students to register on NAD using Aadhaar or NAD ID. If these details are already provided by JNU in the awards data, the certificates are mapped to the registered student for access. If it is desired that Student Registration System of JNU and Student Registration System of NAD are integrated than it can be considered based on technical and operational feasibility and concurrence of MHRD / UGC in this regard. You are requested to share technical document regarding the Student Registration System of JNU so that we can review the same.
