PROF. GILVAN MÜLLER DE OLIVEIRA



Is Associate Professor at the Federal University of Santa Catarina (UFSC) and Head of the UNESCO Chair on Language Policies for Multilingualism (2018–22), based at UFSC, which involves 25 universities in 14 countries. He was Director of the Institute for Research and Development in Language Policy (IPOL) in Florianópolis, Brazil (2002 to 2010) and Executive Director of the International Institute of the Portuguese Language (IILP) of the Community of Portuguese Speaking Countries (CPLP) in Cape Verde (2010 to 2014). His research focuses are on multilingualism and minority languages, as well as the social history of languages.

is currently the Vice Chancellor of Deccan College Post-Graduate and Research Institute (Deemed University), Pune, India. He has served as Professor at the Centre for Linguistics, School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi till October 2019. He has been engaged in teaching and research in Linguistics and English for the past 42 years. Some of the international fellowships that he has been awarded include the Linguistic Institute Fellowship at Stanford University (1987), the Rockefeller Foundation Bellagio Residency Fellowship 2003. He has also been Visiting Professor at CNRS, Paris (2009), and at the University of Frankfurt (2016). His latest book was published in two volumes entitled, Sounds and Their Patterns in Indic Languages, CUP India.








