Corrigendum

Auction Notice Reference No. 3(414)/JNU/SLS/Write-off/2020-21 dated 08.12.2020

Bidders/auctioneers are invited for auction of “**The various condemned surplus/obsolete/condemned old equipments**” of the School of Life Sciences, stored at Old Green House near AIRF, JNU.

The auction of above items at above-stated location in JNU through Spot Auction on “**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS**” shall be held at **11:30 AM on 14th January, 2021** at Old Green House near AIRF, JNU.

1. Eligibility criteria:

Bidders must fulfil following eligibility criteria and submit documents mentioned at **Annexure - I** of this tender document in support of the same as under: -

- (a) Must be registered as a Recycler/Reprocessor/Dismantler of e-Waste with Central Pollution Control Board, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India or with the State Pollution Control Board or State Governments dealing with E-waste etc. Bids received from the firms other than so registered will be summarily rejected.
- (b) Must not be blacklisted by any Department of the Government of India or of any State/or by any PSU/Autonomous Organisation of Government. An Undertaking regarding non-blacklisting of the bidder by any Government Organization must be furnished by the bidder in the tender document in the format given in **Annexure - II**. Bids without above undertaking will not be considered.
- (c) Should be registered with GST/ Service Tax /VAT with Departments of Government of India/State Governments.

2. Inspection of Items

Interested bidders/auctioneers can inspect the material at the above-mentioned location, before auction, in between 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM & 3:00 PM To 4:00 PM from 14.12.2020 to 08.01.2021 in presence of Sh. 3.) The terms and conditions of the auction are as under:-

- a) The auction is on “**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS.**”
- b) **No EMD required.**
- c) The highest bidder shall have to deposit 25% of the bid amount immediately on-the-spot in the form of DD/Pay order/NEFT/RTGS in favour of “**Finance Officer, JNU**”.

- d) The successful bidder will have to pay the balance 75% of the quoted/offered amount in the form of DD/Pay Order/NEFT/RTGS drawn in favour of “**Finance Officer, JNU**”, payable at New Delhi within **two working days** after receipt of letter regarding award of contract, failing which the contract may be cancelled. - e) Transportation and loading/handing etc. will be at the cost of the highest bidder.
- f) The highest bidder will be allowed to take out the dismantled materials from the campus within 7 (seven) days from the date of acceptance of bid after making payment of full bid amount on issue of the gate pass by the School of Life Sciences.
- g) If the bidder does not remove the auctioned dismantle materials from the site within 7 days after depositing the full bid amount Assistant Registrar, SLS may confiscate the balance materials lying at the site and the bidder will have to pay Rs.2,000/- per day as penalty. No material shall be allowed to take out unless the penalty is paid by the bidder.
- h) The security of the dismantled materials would be the entire responsibility of the highest bidder after the bid/ auction and it will be his/her duties/responsibility to any damage one by way of pilferage, fire or any other unforeseen clarity and no claim on this account shall be entertained.
- i) No damage shall be caused to the existing property of this Office or any other Offices in the premises while removing the materials from the site. Any loss/ damage to the property of this Office or any other Offices in the premises or injury or personal accident suffered by any person due to negligence or action of the successful bidder or his authorized worker/supervisor will be borne by successful bidder and they will be indemnified.
- j) The bidder should also enclose the certified copy of the valid registration certificate issued by the Central Pollution Control Board or the State Pollution Control Committee along with the tender document failing which the tender will be rejected. The successful bidder shall produce the original certificate before lifting of the items from said location.**
- k) This tender is non transferable.
- l) This Office reserves the right to accept or reject any bid without assigning or communicating any reason thereof and to take any decision relating to the tender including the cancellation of the tender.
- m) Any corrigendum / addendum / errata etc. in respect of above Tender shall be made available in our official website and Notice Board only. No press publication shall be made in this regard. Hence applicants are advised to visit our website regularly for any amendment / corrigendum / addendums in this regard.

4. Submission of Undertaking for Disposal of e-Waste

The successful bidders shall submit an undertaking (**Annexure - III**) that e-waste items out of various condemned surplus/obsolete/condemned old equipments will be stored/process/disposed off as per **Rule 12 of Chapter IV of e-Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011**.
