JNU has always been known worldwide for freedom of expression, free debate and exchange of ideas of any political ramifications. Here, political discourse and dialogue always have been debated in most healthy and intellectual manner.

JNU has been a hotbed of politics since its inception...where not only political and ideological issues of national importance but even of international significance have been raised and discussed freely but they have never been compromised with the country's sovereign interests, keeping intact its focus on academics and research.

Given this, we strongly condemn anti-national activities and sloganeering in and out of the campus by a few miscreants. The University has always taken steps to contain such activities as and when required in the manners they deem fit.
